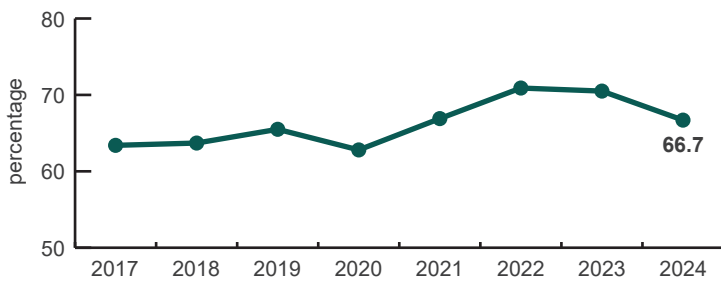


Good Jobs in Northern Ireland 2024

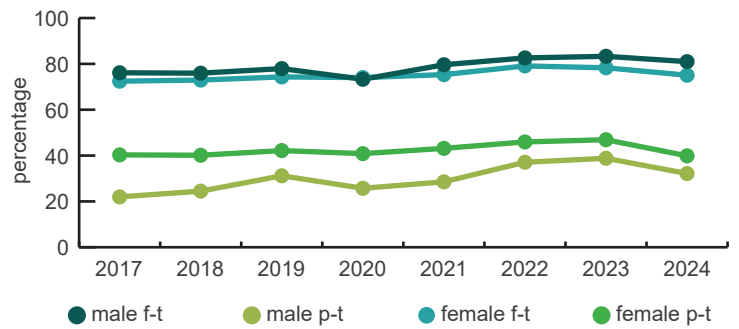

The Economy Minister’s Economic Mission contains an objective to increase the proportion of working-age people in good jobs. A ‘good job’ is one that offers an employee of working age (between 16 and 64) a permanent contract, a non-zero hour contract and the opportunity to earn a Real Living Wage or above. The following looks at the “Good Jobs in Northern Ireland” measure which DfE commissioned NISRA to develop and which is based on the Annual Survey of Hours and Earnings.

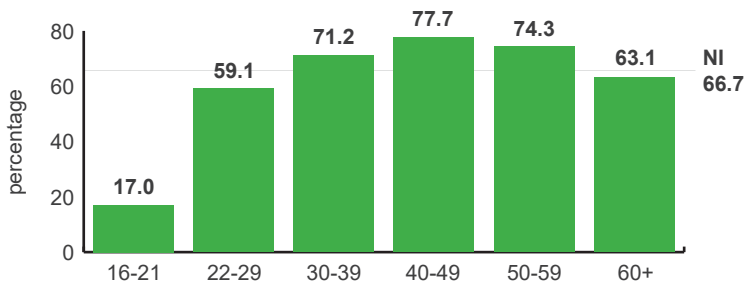
Good jobs rate in NI
2017 to 2024



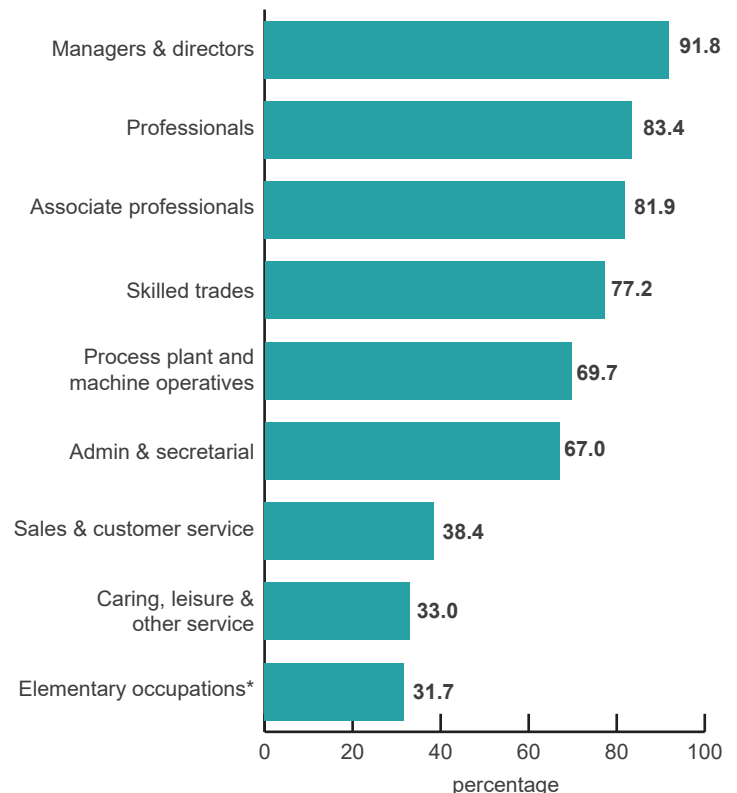
Good jobs rate by gender & ft/pt
2017 to 2024



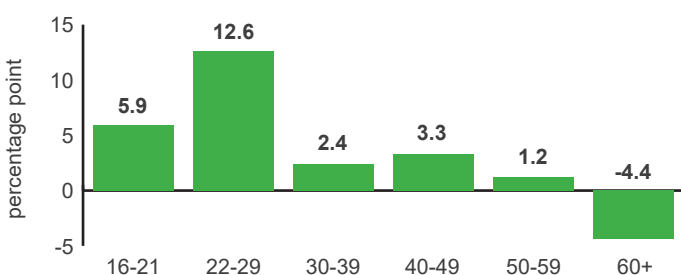
Good jobs rate by age

2024

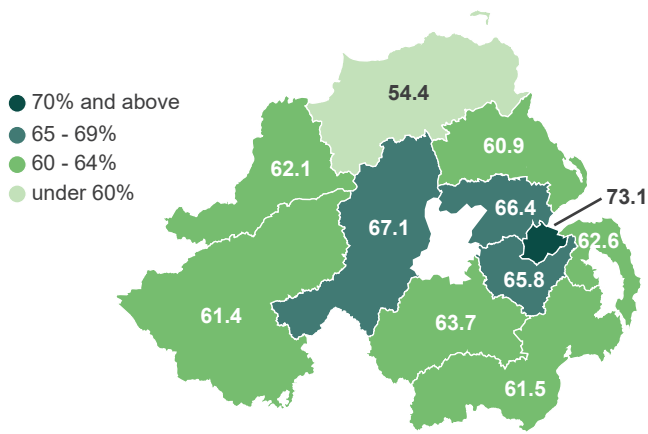


Percentage point change in good jobs rate by age
2017 to 2024

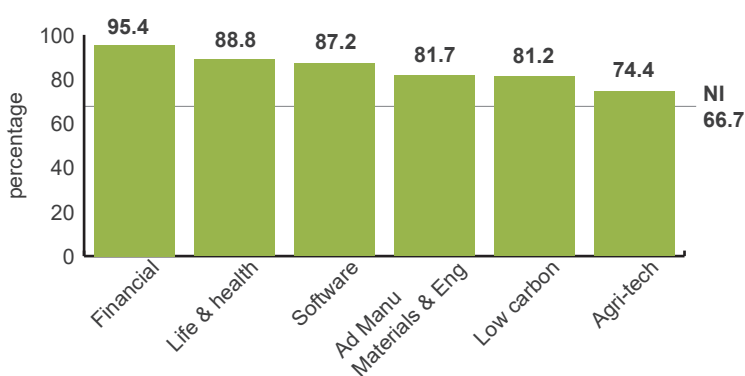


*People employed in elementary occupations usually perform tasks which may require the use of hand-held tools and considerable physical effort.

Good jobs rate by DCA 2024

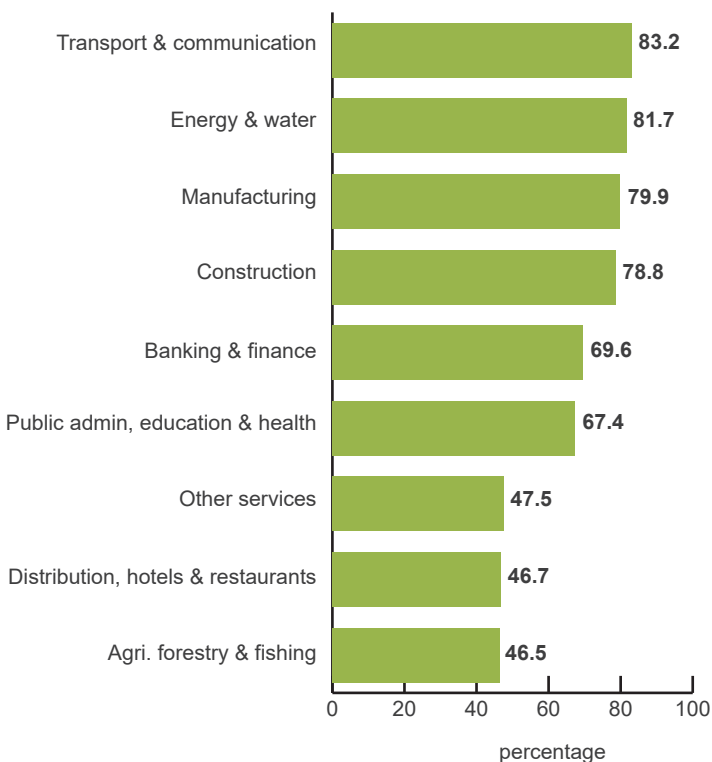


Good jobs rate by priority sectors 2024

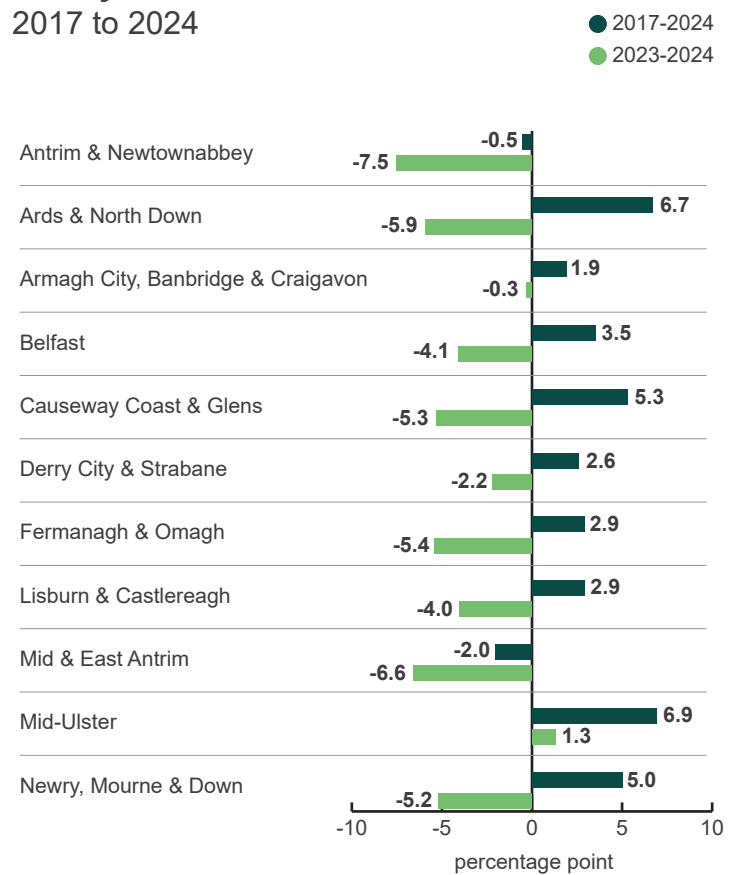


Note: The "Screen Industries" priority sector has been excluded due to the small sample size.
